At adoption, you will receive a medical card of your cat's medical history from the date of intake. If, for any reason, your cat/kitten should become sick or show signs of illness once you take it home (i.e., upper respiratory, ringworm, FeLV, FIV, FIP, etc.), please call your veterinarian.

Kitten Crazy does not assume liability once you take possession of the animal as these conditions may lie dormant and undetectable.

Return Policy

From this day forward the undersigned agrees to accept full responsibility for any behavioral or medical issues that may arise in the below-mentioned cat. If such condition(s) arise, the undersigned agrees to visit a veterinarian to rule out a medical problem. If you are faced with having to find a new home for your Kitten Crazy-adopted cat at any time, please contact us as we will help if space is available and the cat is deemed healthy and well socialized.
